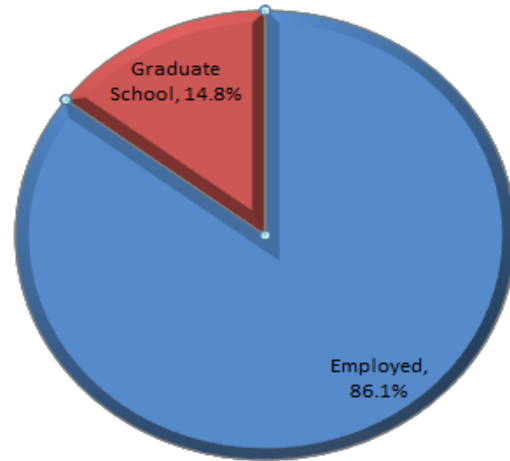
December 2013 & May 2014 Cohort



The information in this report was compiled based on voluntary responses from graduating seniors to inquiries made by the Office of Student Career Development via email requests for post graduation data. In January 2015, seniors were encouraged to complete a survey, which asked them about their plans in the year immediately after graduation. This document summarizes the post-graduate activity for 31.8% of the December 2013/May 2014 cohorts for which current post-SSU information is available.

AN OVERALL PICTURE

Most graduates (86.1%) are employed, while 14.8% are in graduate school.
