- 2) When leaving for the weekend or for a semester break, do not load valuables in the vehicle days before leaving campus. Secure valuables in the trunk, in the residence hall or at home.
- 3) Take advantage of the SSU Operation Identification program and borrow an engraver from the SSU Security Department to mark your valuables.
- 4) Be aware of your surroundings. Notify SSU Security Department at 3232 or 3243 if you see suspicious activity on campus.
