□ A	PROOF OF ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY An official score of 550 (paper-based), or 79 (internet-based), at a minimum, on the <u>Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)</u> or 6 on the <u>International English Language Testing System (IELTS)</u> or 80 on the <u>Michigan English Language Assessment Battery (MELAB)</u> , or an EIKEN of Grade 2A is required for admission to a degree program for students whose native

language is not English.

 For TOEFL to do so, it will need our code. Shawnee State University's code is 1790. If English is your first language this is not required.
PASSPORT COPY A legible copy of your current passport. We MUST be able to see the photo and read the information. If married, the passports of spouse or children are required.
VISA (If currently in the US) Not applicable
CURRENT I-20 Not applicable If you are a transfer student from a college or a university, or finished an undergraduate program in the U.S. you should send us a copy of your I-20.
Proof of financial resources which are adequate to support the student for one year. If you intend to finance your education yourself, you must supply a statement from your bank showing funds equal to those required for one year. If you are being sponsored, an affidavit of support and a bank statement showing adequate funds for one year must be submitted. SSU requires, in either case, that the bank statement must show a minimum amount in US dollars as specified for the academic year (Refer to SSU Admissions office Website for the exact amount: http://shawnee.edu/offices/student-accounts/tuition.aspx). The bank statement must be a recent statement; we cannot accept a statement that is dated more than six months prior to the start of your studies. This amount covers tuition, fees, housing, meals, books and other miscellaneous expenses
CERTIFICATE OF FINANCE A completed Certificate of Finance. Please note that the Certificate of Finance must demonstrate that you have enough financial resources to fund your education abroad. Also, please fill using a computer if possible.
TRANSFER IN FORM A transfer student from a college or a university inside the U.S. should complete this form. This form will be sent after the applicant has sent all other required documents and has been accepted in SSU.
