

The **Radiological Control Technician** is an entry-level position in the nuclear industry. The technician provides field support to the organization with primary emphasis in radiological protection. Under the direction of a supervisor, the technician performs radiological surveys for areas and release of materials; evaluates radiological work, assists in the development of radiological work permits and implements controls consistent with As Low As Reasonably Achievable (ALARA) principles and practices; and provides industrial hygiene and industrial safety support by monitoring work activities for adherence to DOE and Occupational Safety and Health standards.

Department of Energy (DOE) Examination

The Radiological Control Technician Training Program provides the classroom instruction on 13 skill areas required to successfully pass the Department of Energy Radiological Control Exam. Individuals who complete the training and pass the certification exam are qualified to apply for entry-level radiological control technician positions with DOE contractors in the nuclear field.

The Radiological Control Technician Training Program is **260 clock hours** of technical training. The training program is offered by the Ohio South Consortium for Training & Education at the Pike County Career Technology Center, 175 Beaver Creek Road, Piketon, Ohio.

Entrance Requirements

- Complete the Work Keys entrance exams and earn the following scores:*

Applied Mathematics	5 or higher
Locating Information	4 or higher
Reading for Information	5 or higher

*Tests must have been taken within the preceding three years
- Submit completed training application packet and registration fee.
- Submit official transcript of grades from high school and (if applicable) Career Technology Center or College/University.
- Results of FBI/BCI background check. (Results must be mailed to the career technology center).
- Submit resume.
- If selected for the program, pass a 10-panel drug-screening test.

This is a training program sponsored by the Ohio Skills Bank, and the Ohio South Consortium for Training and Education. The class is limited to 15 students.

All applicants are required to pay fees for the entrance examination, application fee and FBI/BCI background check.

A further evaluation of applications, reference checks, and transcripts will result in the selection of the final 15 candidates. These candidates will be required to take a drug test at approximate cost of \$50. A clean drug screening is required for official entrance into the program.
