## Conditional Registration to Teacher Education (C1)

- Level 1 Application w/ Statement of Good Moral Character (Printable from Teacher Ed Website)
- BCI Check     FBI Check
- Additional Background Check/Health Packet for EC & ECIS students only.

## Full Admission (A1)

### PRAXIS/ACT Requirement

Completion of PRAXIS I or ACT tests with minimum scores indicated below is required prior to Level 1 admission.

PRAXIS I

\* Multiple ACT tests may be combined to achieve this score; however, ACT tests may not be combined with Praxis I tests to achieve the desired outcome.

### Successful Completion of Required Courses, Lab, Field/Clinical Experiences

At least 24 Semester hours of university course work must be completed prior to application  
The following courses are required:

- ENG1101 *or* (Grade of C or higher)  
ENG1102
- ENG1105 (Grade of C or higher)
- MATH 1100 *or* (Grade of C or higher)  
*Other approved quantitative reasoning course*
- PSYC 1101 (Grade of C or higher)
- EDUC 1115 (Grade of C or higher)
- Select at least 12 hrs. from GEP or Curriculum Content Area. (See Handbook for GPA Requirements)  
Early Childhood majors may include EDEC1150 & EDEC 2255.
- Satisfactory Essential Assignment (awareness level)
- 2.75 Overall GPA

## Conditional Registration to Licensure Program(C2)

- Level 2 Application (located on TK20)
- Completed Advising Session with Education Advisor
- Full Level 1 Admission

## Full Admission (A2)

### Successful Completion of Required Courses, Lab, Field/Clinical Experiences

At least 60 hrs. of university course work must be completed prior to application

### Professional Ed Requirements

- All 2000-level professional education courses (and Edxx3285 if applicable to your program) with a grade C or better and a 3.0 GPA

### Curriculum Content Requirements

EC:	at least 12 hrs. in curriculum content with a 3.0 GPA
IS:	at least 9 hrs. in curriculum content with a 3.0 GPA
MC:	at least 9 hrs. in each content area with a 3.0 GPA
AYA:	at least 18 hrs. in the content area with a 3.0 GPA
VA:	at least 18 hrs. in the content area with a 3.0 GPA

### GEP Requirements

- Select at least 6 hrs. from GEP or Curriculum Content Area. Curriculum Content Area minimum 3.0 GPA. GEP courses must be C or higher.
- EDUC2230 Educational Media, Technology and Computers.
- 2.75 Overall GPA
- Satisfactory Essential Assignments

- Level 3 Application (located on TK20)
- Statement of Good Moral Character (located on TK20)
- Professional Educator Letter of Recommendation
- Personal Letter of Recommendation
- Full Level 2 Admission

### Successful Completion of Required Courses, and Field/Clinical Experiences

- At least 90 % of content components or curriculum content component with a 3.0 GPA
- All Related Studies Courses completed with grade C or better
- All Professional Education/Licensure courses with the exception of Methods Courses  
(Grades of C or higher and 3.0 GPA)
- All Reading/Literature Requirements  
(Grades of C or higher and 3.0 GPA)
- All GEP Requirements (Grades of C or higher)
- 2.75 Overall GPA
- BCII Check
- FBI Check
- Passed Praxis II Specialty area/content area test
- Satisfactory Essential Assignments
