

Student Conduct Committee Year End Report – 2008

Student Conduct Committee met for three different instances during the course of the year.

Case 1

At a hearing in June 2007, a student was accused of three violations of the Student Code of Conduct against a faculty member on campus:

- III.B.2: Harassment, intimidation, or stalking
- III.B.12: Placing a person or persons in reasonable fear of imminent physical harm
- III.B.15: Communication of a threat (verbal abuse)

The committee met two times to resolve the situation.

Case 2

In December 2007, based on review and discussion of the documentation in this particular case, it was the decision of the committee that they not grant a hearing for the appeal.

Case 3

In April 2008, a student was charged with four violation of the Student Code of Conduct against a university official on campus:

- III.A.1. Violations of a published and/or promulgated professional code of ethics to which the student is bound, i.e. behavior that demonstrates good taste and high moral and ethical behavior.
- III.B.12: Placing a person or persons in reasonable fear of imminent physical harm
- III.B.15: Communication of a threat (verbal abuse)
- III.B.16: Committing or attempting to commit any misdemeanor or felony offense.

The committee met two times to determine sanctions and resolve the situation.
