**REORGANIZATION OF
THE DEPARTMENT OF STUDENT ACTIVITIES
AND HOUSING**

WHEREAS, the President has directed that the student housing operation be strengthened in order to support the expanded residential life needs currently being experienced and the growth anticipated in the near term, and

WHEREAS, ensuring facilities are safe, clean, and provide an environment conducive to student success, and planning for maintenance issues, both current and long term, prompt the need of a manager of operations and facilities who will work and report directly to the Director of Student Activities and Housing; and

WHEREAS the increasing needs of residential students for programmatic, disciplinary, and similar services requires the need for additional staff focused on student development; and

WHEREAS, in response the Vice President for Student Affairs has reviewed the University's housing operation and has proposed an organizational structure that incorporates research-based residential-life programs that requires the re-distribution of essential duties and responsibilities among the existing staff; and

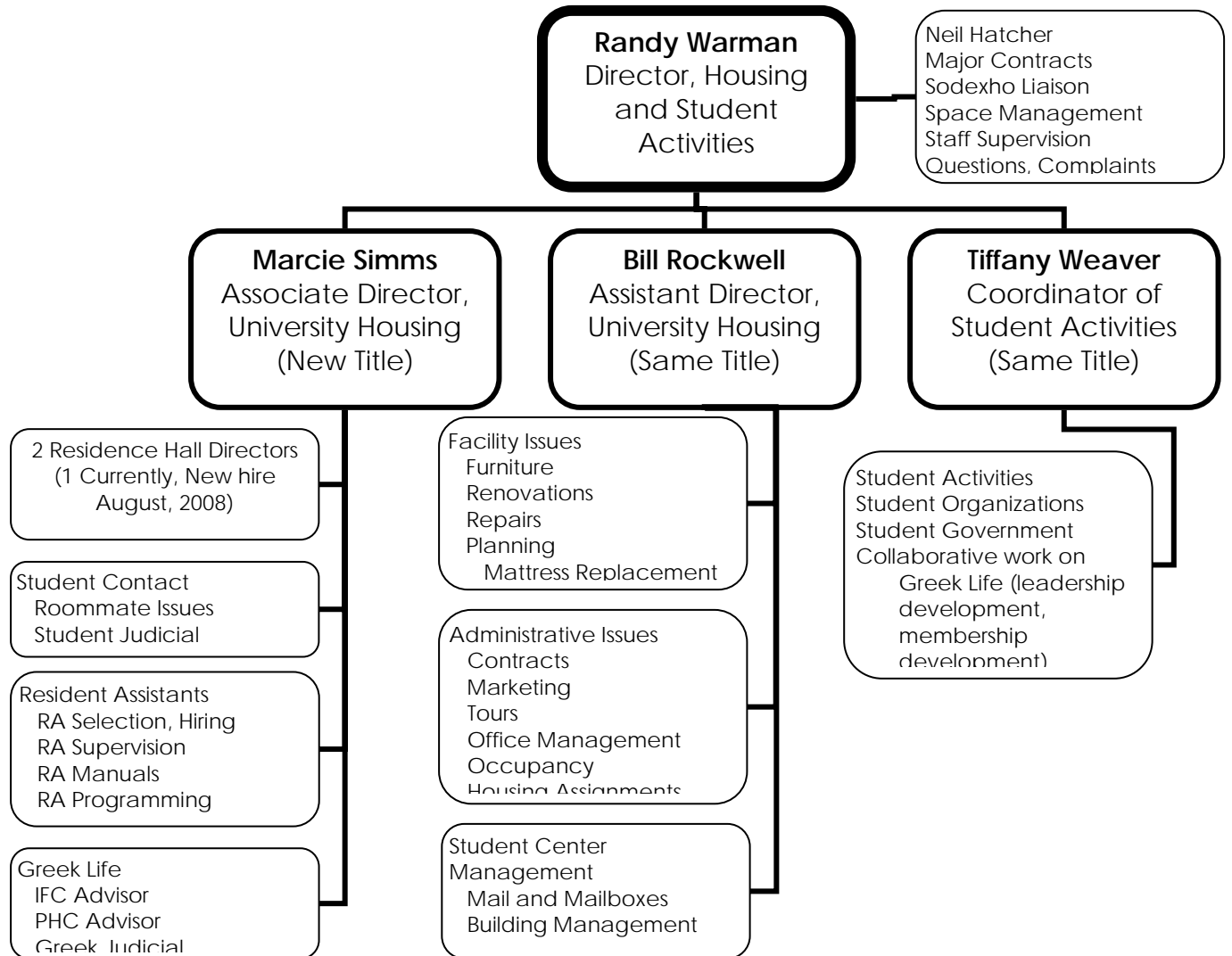
WHEREAS, the Vice President for Business Affairs has reviewed the plan and has determined that additional costs will be minimal;
