First-Year Students — Transition to College Life with Shawnee Connect

If you are a first-year student, the Shawnee Connect Program can help you transition to college life — and improve your chances of success.

Shawnee Connect pairs you with a mentor during your first year so you have someone on the “inside” to help answer all of your questions. Your mentor will be a faculty or staff member who can help you with your transition to college and help you make the connections you need to make with the campus community.

If you enroll in the program, your mentor will treat you to lunch twice during the fall semester and will be available throughout your first year to talk with you as questions come up.

Students who have participated in Shawnee Connect have shown better grade point averages and a higher likelihood to continue with college than first-year students who do not participate in the program.
