

# Manufacturing Skills Standards Council (MSSC)

This course prepares the student to sit for the MSSC certification exams in the areas of Manufacturing Processes, Maintenance Awareness, Quality and Safety. The course examines fundamentals and interrelationships of these four components to provide a universal and foundational understanding of manufacturing as a system. Understanding manufacturing as a system helps students evaluate the impact of decisions, solve problems, be innovative, and contribute more fully to advance manufacturing firms.
