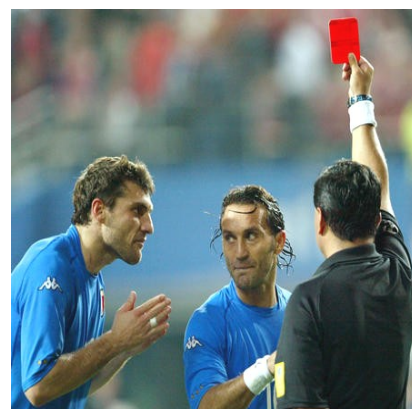

This 25-hour officiating class, as required by Ohio High School Athletic Association, will cover rules, regulations and mechanics as set forth by OHSAA. Course will consist of classroom and on-field training. An open book test will be conducted at the conclusion of the class with a score of 75 required to pass. Passing of the state test will make you eligible to officiate high school soccer contests during the Spring 2012 soccer season.
