### **American Water Works Association (AWWA) (pending)**

Criteria: A superior project devoted to scientific research surrounding drinking water.  
Award: Certificate and \$50 Savings Bond (1 per District)

### **Ohio Water Environment Association (OWEA)**

Criteria: A superior project devoted to scientific research dealing with environmental issues related to water  
Award: Certificate and \$100 (1 per District)

### **B-WISER Awards (pending)**

Criteria: Outstanding project at District 14 Science Day – **Available ONLY to 7<sup>th</sup> grade girls**  
Award: \$50 partial Scholarship to attend B-WISER Science Camp, Summer 2010  
(3 Awards)

### **Ohio Soybean Awards**

Criteria: Best Projects in the area of agriculture bio-sciences, bio-resources, biopolymers, bio-products, and/or bio-fuels using soybeans  
Award: \$100 Cash (Up to 3 Awards may be given)

### **District 14 Outstanding School Award:**

Schools with four or more projects at District Science Day will be eligible for this award.

**Criteria for District 14 Outstanding School Award:** Schools with a minimum of 4 projects must have 100% of their projects earn a Superior rating. Schools with more than 4 projects must have 80% of their projects earn a Superior rating.

**Students (grades 5-12) MUST receive a superior rating at District Science Day to be eligible to participate at State Science Day**
