 Tents shall be adequately roped, braced and anchored to withstand the elements of weather and prevent against collapsing. Documentation of structural stability shall be furnished to the Code Official. Anchor per manufacturer's recommendations and/or installation specifications. High Wind Action Plan may be required for events at the discretion of the Code Official.

- Tent structure to be open sided, unless specifically approved as a part of this approval. Required number of occupants / exit as follows; 0-9; 1 exit @ 36", 10-199; 2 exits @ 72" each, 200-499; 3 exits @ 72" each, 500-999; 4 exits @ 96" each, 1000-1999; 5 exits @ 120" each, 2000-2999; 6 exits @ 120" each, 3000+; 7 exits @ 120" each. When the occupant load exceeds 3,000, the total width of means of egress (in inches) shall not be less than the total occupant load multiplied by 0.2 inches per person.
- Tent to be located from other structures or tents on the site per "Bureau Policy for Tent Permit". Applications in conflict with this policy require approval of the Code Official.
- Tent fabric flammability test report(s) to be posted on site: indicating compliance <u>ONLY</u> to NFPA 701 as required. Permanent sewn-in fabric certification must be displayed for inspection and not to be removed.
- Exits shall be spaced at approximately equal intervals around the perimeter of the tent and shall be located such that all points are 100 feet or less from an exit.
- Exit signs shall be either listed in accordance with UL 924 and as listed as the internally illuminated type and used in accordance with the listing or shall be externally illuminated by luminaires.
- Provide Temporary or Permanent toilet facilities within 500' of this structure for both male & female occupants. Accessible facilities required to a ratio of, (1) accessible: (6) standard per OBC, section; 102.8.1.
- No cooking under tent, unless specifically approved by the State of Ohio Fire Marshall's Office per OFC, sections 2404.15 to 2404.16. Contact the office of the S.F.M @ 614-752-8200.
- Heaters either solid and liquid fuel, natural gas or L.P. gas to comply per Ohio Fire Code, sections 2404.15 to 2404.16. Tanks and "open flame" appliances to be outside and min. 20'+ from the tent, and are to be secured in place.
- Approved "No Smoking" signs shall be conspicuously posted.
