- An on-line application for admission accompanied by a \$40 application fee. The application form is accessible at <https://applyto.shawnee.edu/international.aspx>
- Copies of all official secondary (high school) and, if applicable, postsecondary (college or university) transcripts actual diploma. All transcripts/diplomas must be copies of the original and in the student's native language and must be accompanied by a certified English translation.

All required documents must be received about two months prior to the beginning of classes for the term you plan to begin your studies.

- Proof of financial resources to provide adequate funds for one year of study in the United States. An official bank statement dated no more than 6 months prior to the start of your studies must show a minimum of \$24,000 in US dollars.
