

CREATING A TEMPORARY ACCOUNT TO APPLY FOR LEVEL 1 ADMISSION IN TK20

To create your temporary application account in TK20, using only **Google Chrome** or **Firefox**, type this into the browser: **tk20.shawnee.edu** (do not use www. at beginning). TK20 is not fully supported in Internet Explorer.

NOTE: Do not use your SSU email address; you may use a personal email address or make up an email address. This address will not be used again in TK20.

Immediately you will be given your username and password for the temporary application account.

This is the only time that you will use this account. Once you have earned admission, you will be given a new username and password for your active student TK20 account.

YOU DO NOT NEED TO REGISTER YOUR STUDENT ACCOUNT; PLEASE IGNORE THE LINK TO DO SO. Follow the instructions listed here to create your initial application account.

Teacher Education is a selective admissions program. That means you have to apply to be admitted (Level 1 to enroll in 2000-level education courses), and you apply again to continue (Level 2 to enroll in 3000-level education courses) and yet again to be approved for your student teaching experience (Level 3).

To apply for Level 1 admission you must first create a temporary account in TK20. Click on the **ADMISSIONS** link below, then to **CLICK HERE TO CREATE YOUR ACCOUNT**. Your temporary TK20 account is for this application only and will not be used again. Once admitted, you will be given an active student account that will be used throughout your education program.

Applications for Levels 2 & 3 are found under the **APPLICATIONS** tab of your active student account once you are officially admitted at Level 1.
