In order to participate in the Healthcare track of the SSU Teacher Bootcamp you are required to have a Covid Vaccine or a declination form, a shadowing form, and have a current 2 Step TB test (completed within the year). A **2-step TB (tuberculosis) test** is often required for individuals shadowing in healthcare-related fields or academic programs. Here's what it involves:

## A 2-step TB test uses the Mantoux tuberculin skin test (TST) and is performed in two parts:

- 1. **Step 1**:
  - A small amount of PPD (purified protein derivative) is injected under the skin of your forearm.
  - o You return 48–72 hours later to have the site examined for a reaction.
  - o If the result is **negative**, proceed to step 2.
- 2. **Step 2** (Performed 7 days after the first test is read):
  - o The test is repeated on the **other arm**.
  - o Again, return in 48–72 hours to have it read
