(\$1,000-\$3,000/year)

If you earned at least 30 credit hours at another university or community college, we want to help you complete your degree at Shawnee State University. Students with an associate's degree receive an additional \$1,000.

### SSU Legacy Scholarship

If your parent or grandparent graduated from SSU and you have a high school GPA of at least a 2.5, you may be eligible for a \$500 legacy scholarship. This scholarship is stackable with other merit and athletic scholarships. A separate application is required.
