

Resident Move-In Packing Guide

Bedroom

- Twin XL bedding (pillows, sheets, blankets, etc.)
- Mattress topper
- Hangers
- Laundry basket/bag
- Small trash can
- Personal decorations
- Mattress pad

Bathroom

- Towels and washcloths
- Toiletries (shampoo, toothbrush, deodorant, etc.)
- Toilet paper
- Shower curtain (Townhouse & Cedar only)
- First aid kit (shared)

Kitchen

- Dishes (plates, cups, bowls, silverware) (shared)
- Dish drying rack/soap (shared)
- Pots and pans (shared)
- Cooking utensils (shared)

- Kitchen towels (shared)
- Trash can/bags (shared)
- Microwave (optional/shared)
- Toaster

Living/Shared Space

- TV (optional/shared)
- Decorations (optional/shared)
- Floor lamp or extra lighting (optional/shared)
- Area Rug (optional/shared)

Miscellaneous

- Cleaning & Laundry supplies
- Quarters for laundry (\$2.50 per load)
- Phone charger
- Surge protector

Prohibited Items

- Candles, Wax Warmers, Incense
- Pets
- Dartboards
- Weapons, Illicit Drugs, Paraphernalia
- LED light strips
- Command strips/hooks

Reminders

- All apartment furniture must remain in the unit. Furniture covers are required for any apartment with an approved ESA.
- All ESA and ADA accommodations must be formally approved in advance through our Accessibility Services Coordinator.
- Shared items—coordinate with housemates to avoid duplicates (TV, dishes, etc.).
- Please keep in mind the **importance of cleanliness** throughout the year. Final apartment inspections determine **cleaning and damage charges**, which may impact your student account.
