We'll hold a mini kindergarten day complete with a morning meeting, writing, math games, read-a-loud stories, recess, science experiments and more. This class is a great way to gain confidence and get excited about the coming school year! Open to any children going into kindergarten (at any school).

Kindergarten – Full Day

Kindergarten Kids - (Students currently completing K and entering 1st in the Fall of 2024) A little bit of this, a little bit of that and a whole lot of FUN! Students will experience a myriad of activities designed to bust summer boredom all themed around amazing storybooks. Combining many activities and themes, the K class gives your child a chance to experience some of the best we have to offer at Cub Camp- math, science, literacy, and more!

Archery (Grades 4-8) Students learn all aspects of archery and various types of shooting with safety being the main priority. Instructor David Shoupe

Cheer Champs (Grades 1-8) Learn how to be a cheerleader! You will learn exciting and crowd effective sidelines, cheers and band chants to become the ultimate crowd leader at your school. Create excitement by using poms, signs and proper spicing techniques! Learn all of the fundamentals of cheerleading: motions, voice inflection, jumps, incorporating crowd effective stunts and more. Color Your World (Grades 1-8) Explore and create with this fun and engaging session! Students will be provided in-depth opportunities to explore art-making with emphasis on all stages of the creative process: conceptualization, planning, and execution. *Approved for funding from the South Central Ohio ESC Scholarship Program, if camper is eligible*

Cookies & Cards (Grades 1-3) What's better than games and snacks? In this class we will bake/make a different cookie each day and play a card game while we wait for our treat. Cookies will include iced oatmeal, no bake, chocolate chip, and sugar. Card games will include go fish, rummy, and more! Instructor Amy Smalley

"Exploring Greek Mythology (Grades 4-8) Students will explore Greek Gods and Goddesses, learn ancient Greek lettering, and find real-world connections with mythology. Students will also create their own mythical creature that are inspired by ancient Greek history! At the end of the week students will test their knowledge in an Ancient Greek inspired escape room. Myth Busters (Grades 3-8) WARNING: Science in Progress! Come explore science, the myth busters way! The Mythbusters mix scientific method, gleeful curiosity and plain old-fashioned ingenuity to create their own signature style of explosive experimentation. This week we will join in on the fun! On Broadway - Making a Musical: The Wizard of Oz (Grades 3-5) Come join us on a musical journey to an amazing land of witches, monkeys and "Lions, and tigers and bears, oh my!!" We will explore the behind-the-scenes look into what it means to a part of putting on a musical. You will learn about reading music, memorizing lines and choreography, and becoming a character. We will learn a song and dance from the "Wizard of Oz," to perform at the end of the week and even do some costume and prop-making crafts during the week.
