

SSU Financial Aid Authorization

The Department of Education permits the use of financial aid (including student loans) for charges other than tuition and fees, and on-campus room and board only by your authorization to do so.

Program regulations permit you to authorize use of financial aid funds for expenses such as books and supplies, miscellaneous housing charges, miscellaneous fines, or campus debit systems such as the Bear Card program. If you are eligible for financial aid in excess of tuition and fees, and you wish to use this excess to cover other charges (e.g. books, miscellaneous housing charges, miscellaneous fines, etc.) you must authorize Shawnee State University to pay these charges from your account balance. **You may rescind this authorization at any time prior to incurring such charges. If you cancel it once such charges have been made on your behalf, you will be responsible for those charges.** This authorization is valid for funds in excess of tuition and fees, based on your financial aid eligibility and enrollment status.

Housing Requirements

- All freshman and sophomore students in their first and second year of attendance and who live more than 25 miles from campus are required to live in housing.
- All varsity student athletes and/or international students receiving any institutional scholarship assistance are required to live in housing.

Housing Exemptions

- Exceptions to this policy include:
 - Students living with one or both of their parents
 - Married students
 - Single parents with full or shared custody of children
 - Veteran students
 - Students over the age of 23
 - Transfer students with more than sixty (60) transferred credits earned beyond high school graduation (CCP/AP)
 - Other extenuating circumstances

Contact Release

- All Housing Contracts are for the entire academic year or balance thereof. A resident must have an approved release from the contract in writing to terminate charges for room and/or meal plan.
- To petition for contract release, students must submit the [Petition for Contract Release](#) form and provide any documentation that supports their case.




