 - Fall semester dates: August 8th through September 1st







Housing & Residence Life



Housing Requirements

- All freshman and sophomore students in their first and second year of attendance and who live more than 25 miles from campus are required to live in housing.
- All varsity student athletes and/or international students receiving any institutional scholarship assistance are required to live in housing.



SSU housing is ranked #196 in the nation and #7 in Ohio by Niche

Housing Exemptions

- Exceptions to this policy include:
 - Students living with one or both of their parents
 - Married students
 - Single parents with full or shared custody of children
 - Veteran students
 - Students over the age of 23
 - Transfer students with more than sixty (60) transferred credits earned beyond high school graduation (CCP/AP)
 - Other extenuating circumstances



Contact Release

- All Housing Contracts are for the entire academic year or balance thereof. A resident must have an approved release from the contract in writing to terminate charges for room and/or meal plan.
- To petition for contract release, students must submit the <u>Petition for Contract Release</u> form and provide any documentation that supports their case.






Roommate Matching Visual
