#### **FREE-TUITION**

Do you live in Scioto, Lawrence, Gallia, Jackson, Vinton, Ross, Pike, Adams, or Brown Counties in Ohio – or Greenup, Boyd or Lewis Counties in Kentucky? You could be eligible for Free Tuition at Shawnee State! Students who qualify for federal Pell Grants, have a high school GPA of 3.0 and ACT score of at least 18 are eligible.

#### **MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS**

Apply to Shawnee State and send us your transcripts and ACT/SAT scores by December 1, 2025 for first consideration for merit-based scholarships. Apply by February 1, 2026 for priority consideration for merit-based awards and limited full-tuition scholarships. Scholarships will be awarded through June 15, 2026 while funds last.

#### SSU LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP

If your parent or grandparent graduated from SSU and you have a high school GPA of at least a 2.5, you may be eligible for a \$500 legacy scholarship. This scholarship is stackable with other merit and athletic scholarships. A separate application is required.

#### TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS

(\$1.500 - \$3.500/year)

If you began your education at another university or community college, finish your degree at Shawnee State University. Students with an associate's degree receive an additional \$1,000.
