

UBMS Participant Contract

Student Name

To be eligible for participation in Upward Bound Math Science (UBMS) activities during the academic year and summer component, UBMS expects the following:

- Once accepted, you will be a UBMS student until graduation of high school, and then up to 6 years of college, or until you finish a minimum of an associate degree, whichever comes first (You **do not** have to reapply for the program each year.)
- Check the UBMS Facebook page (Shawnee State UBMS) daily. We will post announcements and other important information throughout the year.
- You are responsible for submitting your monthly assignments on time and done correctly. Assignments will be due at the following Saturday Activity.

To be eligible for the \$20 stipend, you must attend the previous Saturday Activity, and have all homework up to date. If you are absent from the activity, you must email your homework to a UBMS staff member prior to the date that it is due. The stipend amount will be determined as follows:

Attendance + Homework completed, correct and on time = \$20

Homework completed, correct and on time (without attendance) = \$10

Seniors: Attendance at senior meeting with additional senior assignments completed= double amounts listed above

***All homework must be completed on time to remain eligible for Winter Retreat and Summer Residential Program, and any other special activity/trip.**

- Attendance at Saturday Activities
Excused Absence = school related activity only. You must complete form and notify UBMS at least one week prior to scheduled activity.
Unexcused Absence = work, family outings, or any other reason. Part of the program is learning how to manage a schedule
- * You will be allowed 2 unexcused absences and still remain eligible for program activities. In the case of inclement weather, an absence will not count against you. The Parent/Guardian Meeting/Summer Orientation in the spring is the only mandatory activity. A make-up assignment will be sent to any student who misses a Saturday Activity (unexcused).
- College visits will be offered to all active students in UBMS.
- A copy of your midterm grades and grade card must be turned into your In-School Coordinator when they are released.

- A monthly Progress Report will be emailed to the Director by your In-School Coordinator
- Monthly meeting with In-School Coordinator.
- A copy of all ACT scores must be turned in to UBMS staff or the In-School Coordinator.
- If you fall below a 2.5 GPA or earn a “C” or below in any academic course, the UBMS staff will contact your high school guidance counselor and tutoring services will be required.
- Homework assignments and attendance will be strongly enforced for special UBMS activities. For example, if the UBMS budget only allows us to take 30 students on Winter Retreat, the 30 who have completed work on time and have attended regular meetings will be awarded the first spots.
